Cesspool Conversion Working Group [Final Report](#) to the 2023 Regular Session Legislature recommendation:

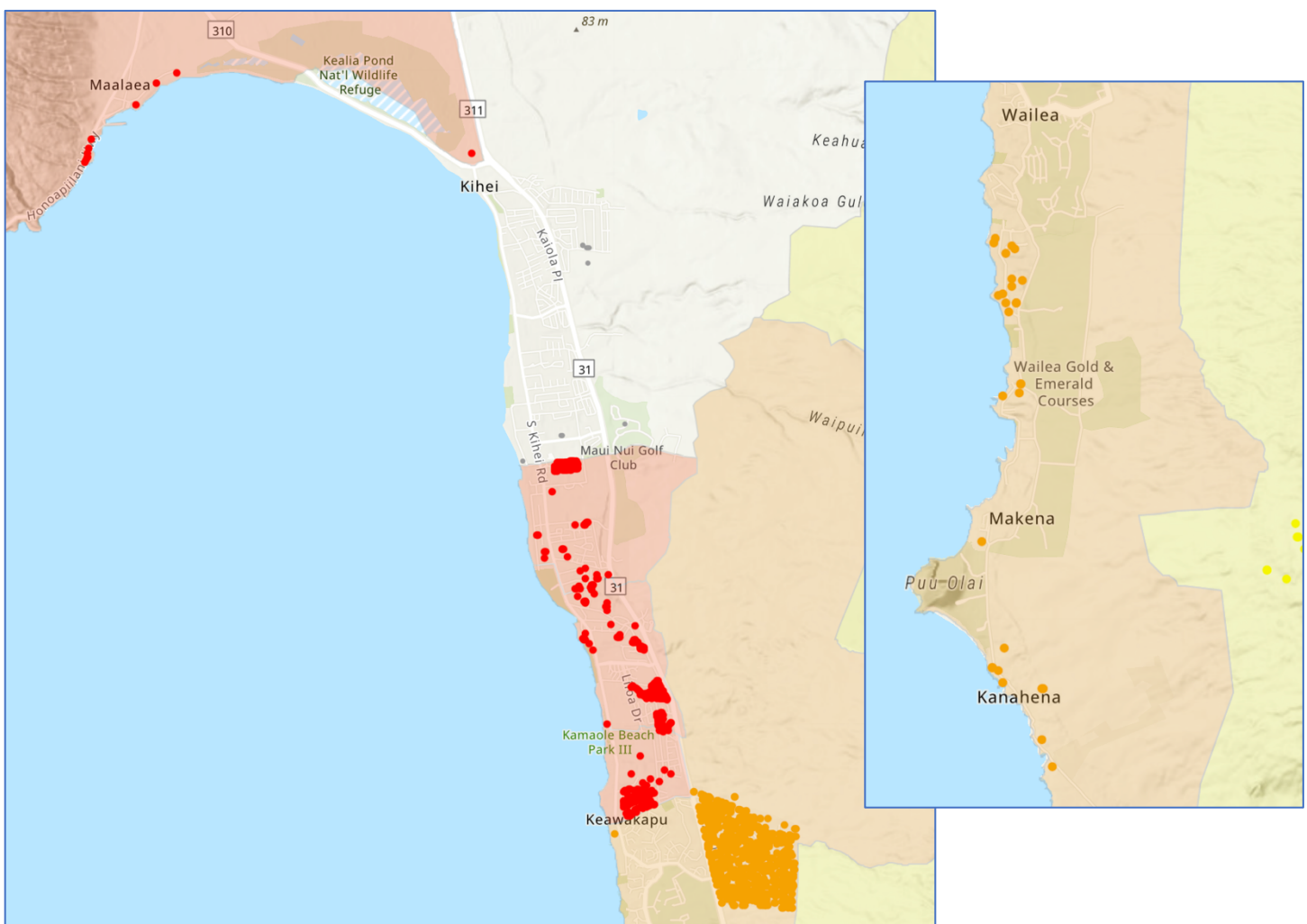
A1. Replace the 2050 deadline, from Act 125 Session Laws of Hawaii (SLH) 2017, for cesspool conversion as follows:

- Priority 1 zones (13,821 cesspools) converted by 2030
- Priority 2 zones (12,367 cesspools) converted by 2035
- Priority 3 zones (55,237 cesspools) converted by 2050

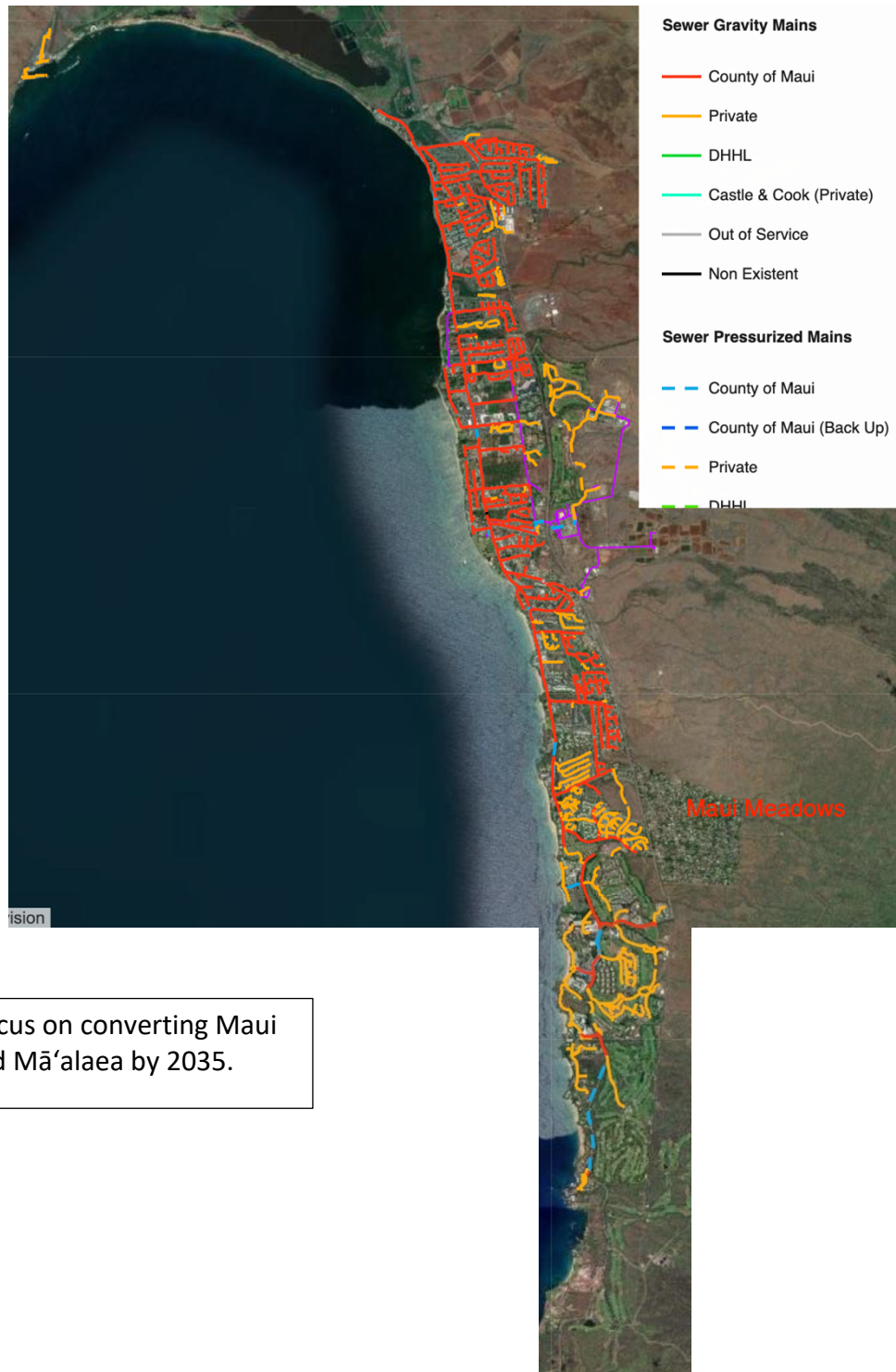
The Hawai'i Cesspool Prioritization Tool October 2022:

"To address pollution concerns, the Hawai'i State Legislature mandated replacement of all cesspools by 2050. A major step in achieving this goal is to categorize cesspools based on potential or realized harm to humans and the environment."

Red dots are priority 1, orange dots are priority 2.



However, few, if any, of the red dot properties in Kihei currently have cesspools. Many of them have never had them, and almost all have public or private sewer lines.



We should focus on converting Maui Meadows and Māʻālaea by 2035.
