PHASE 3 OF AFFORDABLE RENTAL HOUSING DEVELOPMENT IN KIHEI ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS

Hale O Pi'ikea III Is Designed for Families Earning 30-60% Area Median Income



(Kihei, Maui - September xx, 2025) – Applications are now being accepted and are accessible through the community website at: https://mdihawaii.com/rentals/hale-o-piikea-phase-3/ for Hale O Pi'ikea III, the third phase of an affordable rental housing initiative by 'Ikenākea Development that will deliver a total of 223 rental homes upon completion. Phase III is slated to open in January 2026 and will include 35 units: 11 one-bedroom, 16 two-bedroom and 8 three-bedroom apartments, with maximum rents (including utilities) ranging from up to \$757 to \$2,100. The project's managing agent, Mark Development, has begun accepting applications and a lottery will be held to determine the order in which applicants are processed for eligibility. Lottery selections for these residential workforce housing units will be prioritized with a preference given to residents of Maui County. Please be advised that those interested in being entered in the lottery must submit their applications by Monday, October 13th, 2025 at 5:00 p.m. Applications received after this date will be placed on a waitlist in the order received. This project is designed for individuals and families earning between 30 percent and 60 percent of the Area Median Income (AMI) and represents a significant step in addressing Maui's critical housing needs. Strategically located in Kihei at the intersection of Pi'ikea Avenue and Liloa Drive, the Hale O Pi'ikea Affordable Rental Housing Development provides residents with easy access to public transportation, health and social services, government offices, as well as shopping, dining and employment opportunities.
